Sunday	Romans 8	1-9 10-17 18-25 26-27 28-31 32-39	+ The freedom of believers from condemnation. + Their privileges as being the children of God. + Their hopeful prospects under tribulations. + Their assistance from the Spirit in prayer. + Their interest in the love of God. + Their final triumph, through Christ.
Monday	Romans 9	1-5 6-13 14-24 25-29 30-33	+ The apostle's concern that his countrymen were strangers to the gospel. + The promises are made good to the spiritual seed of Abraham. + Answers to objections against God's sovereign conduct, in exercising mercy & justice. + This sovereignty is in God's dealing both with Jews and Gentiles. + The falling short of the Jews is owing to their seeking justification, not by faith, but by the works of the law.
Tuesday	Romans 10	1-4 5-11 12-17 18-21	+ The apostle's earnest desire for the salvation of the Jews. + The difference between the righteousness of the law, and the righteousness of faith. + The Gentiles stand on a level with the Jews, in justification and salvation. + The Jews might know this from Old Testament prophecies.
Wednesday	Romans 11	1-10 11-21 22-32 33-36	+ The rejection of the Jews is not universal. + God overruled their unbelief for making the Gentiles partakers of gospel privileges. + The Gentiles cautioned against pride and unbelief, The Jews shall be called as a nation, and brought into God's visible covenant again. + A solemn adoring of the wisdom, goodness, and justice of God.
Thursday	Romans 12	1-2 3-8 9-16 17-21	+ Believers are to dedicate themselves to God. + To be humble, and faithfully to use their spiritual gifts, in their respective stations. + Exhortations to various duties. + Be peaceful towards all men
Friday	Romans 13	1-7 8-10 11-14	+ The duty of subjection to governors. + Exhortations to mutual love. + Awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer
Saturday	Romans 14	1-13 14-23	+ The Jewish converts cautioned against judging, and Gentile believers against despising one the other. + And the Gentiles exhorted to take heed of giving offence in their use of indifferent things.
