


Philippians

- It was written by St. Paul in the year 63 A.D while he was in prison in Rome.
- St. Paul visited Philippi to preach in it in the year 52 A.D. There, Lydia the seller became a Christian as mentioned in the book of Acts 16.
- When the Philippians knew that St. Paul was captured in prison, they sent Epaphroditus with gifts for him. Then, Epaphroditus became sick and when he became better, St. Paul resent him to Philippi with that letter.
- Although St. Paul was in prison, this letter is called **the letter of Joy** as the word Joy is present 16 times in the letter.
- St. Paul is inviting us to rejoice in our lord Jesus Christ always whatever our condition is.
