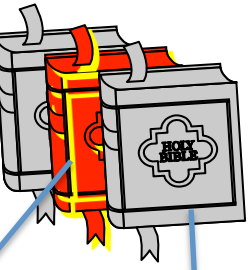

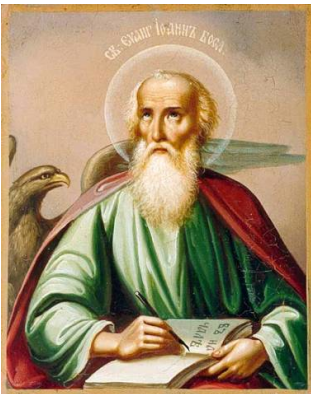

St. John was mentioned 35 times in the New Testament



WHO IS ST. JOHN?

1. He was the son of Zebedee and Salome
2. He was the disciple of John the Baptist
3. He was a fisherman
4. He was the brother of St. James (Sons of Thunder)
5. He was in Jesus' inner circle together with St. Peter and St. James
6. His name means "God is gracious"
7. He was the only disciple who followed Jesus to the Cross
8. Jesus entrusted him with His mother at His Crucifixion
9. He was the bishop of 7 churches in Asia Minor
10. He was exiled to the Island of Patmos
11. He returned to Ephesus, where he died in the year 100 AD
12. He is the only apostle that was not martyred
13. Always referred to as "the disciple whom Jesus loved"

- ❖ Washing the disciples' feet
- ❖ The chapters of the Paraclete (read in the 1st hour of the eve of Good Friday)
- ❖ Jesus' prayer for His disciples
- ❖ Jesus' appearance to Mary in the garden
- ❖ Doubting Thomas
- ❖ Jesus' appearance on the lake after the resurrection and Peter's restoration


Written between AD 90-100 in Ephesus
