


Introduction to Service





- Service is neither an art nor a science.
- It starts in the heart, and its school is the Holy Spirit, which inflames, sanctifies and teaches the heart.



- Service is a holy love that is not limited to either a definitive service, place or time.
- Service is an important source of happiness: "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35).



Service can not be restricted: "The word of God is not chained" (2 Timothy 2:9)







God's Servant - Spirituality



- The servant has to be at a higher spiritual level than those whom she/he is serving.
- She/He has to be pure in their thoughts, their behavior and their life in general.



- She/He reflects the true Christian life by example not by words.
- She/He must be an example of virtue.
- She/He must be well rooted in the correct teachings and dogma of the Church.

God's Servant - Personality



- A servant has to have a special character.
- She/he has to have leadership qualities.





- She/he has to avoid such weaknesses as anger and slips of the tongue.
- She/he has to have wisdom.




* "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to my Father" (John 14:12)

- Her/his struggle does not stop until he "presents every man perfect in Jesus Christ" (Colossians 1:28).




- The value of every soul is the blood of Christ for He died on the Cross to save it.

- "I have fought the good fight. I have finished the race. I have kept the faith" (2 Timothy 4:7)




The selection of a Servant

Fights against Service



Financial: "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19)





Feeling of unworthiness: "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." (Luke 5:8) "Do not be afraid, from now on, you will catch men" (Luke 5:10)



- Waiting for God's call: A supernatural proof is not required to verify what is already established.
- Jealousy: Serving God is based on love, and love does not intermix with jealousy.
- Self-righteousness: Never ever take credit for the fruit of your service. Give the glory to God.

- Service in its general meaning is not limited to teaching.




- The miracle of the paralytic: the four member spiritual rescue team






