

The Urgency of Repentance




 The ministry [preaching] of Christ and Saint John the Baptist both revolved around the phrase
 "Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand" (Matthew 3:2, 4:17)
 Christ also said "Unless

you repent you will all likewise perish" (Luke 13:5)

The Meaning of Repentance

- Sin is a separation from God
- Repentance is the reconciliation [return] to God
- Repentance is an acceptance of God's invitation to live a life of holiness.




How do I repent? 1. Personal feeling of guilt 2. Sitting down alone to re-examine yourself while feeling God's mercy and acceptance towards repentant sinners. 3. Confession to God in the presence of Abouna

Confession with Abouna, why?

God has appointed priests to accept the confessions of the believers and offer them to Him on the altar.




What do I confess?

- Concerning your relationship with God
 Spiritual Growth in Prayer, reading the Holy Bible, taking Holy Communion, fasting, etc.
- Concerning your relationship with yourself and others
- CONFESS ALL SINS whether in thought, sense or action.



How much detail?

- Only the detail that reveal the motives of the sin
- Unnecessary detail that does not help your repentance do not describe.
- Do not justify yourself to Abouna
- Do not be embarrassed [shy] in front of Abouna
- Always tell the truth regardless because has previously heard all the sins you can imagine.
