The First, Second & Third Epistle of John

- **Author:** first John is so similar to the Gospel of John in language, style & theology, that few have ever disputed that the two books were written by the same man: St. John the Apostle.
- **Date:** The letter can't be dated with certainty. It is probable that all of John's letters were written about the same time (A.D. 90-95).
- Major Theme: * First Epistle of John: Tests of true Christian life.
 - * Second Epistle of John: Tests of true Christian care.
 - * Third Epistle of John: Genuine leadership vs. false leadership.

Subthemes:

- 1- Our participation or communion with God & with each other.
- 2- The close relationship of faith, love, obedience, & life- the all inclusive term of salvation.
- 3- The close relationship between the first great commandment, love of God, & the second, love of others.
- 4- The crucial importance of holding true faith.
- 5- A stark, eschatological contrast between the children of God & the children of the world.
