Dear beloved, the Church teaches us that the Feast of Resurrection is the most important Church celebration and it surpasses all other feasts. As St. Paul the Apostle said: "And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty." (1Cor. 15:4)

Without the Resurrection of our Lord, there would be no meaning to Christianity.
